



West Side Track Club is going to the AAU Junior Olympics Again!

Louisville's West Side Track Club was started in 1982 and has become one of the nation's leading track and field programs for boys and girls, ages 7-18. They are based at the Norton Sports and Learning Center where they practice 4 afternoons a week. Led by coaches Shonna Johnson and Edward Newton, the program focuses not only on developing athletic ability but also discipline, accountability, sportsmanship, and teamwork. They have produced numerous Kentucky High School State Champions and more National Champions than any other track team in Louisville.

Most importantly they "encourage activities that help members develop their full potential as young people."

They are preparing to compete in the AAU Junior Olympic Games in Greensboro, North Carolina from July 30 - August 6. This year over 70 young athletes qualified for the meet, which is 28 more than last year!
